



# SCHOOL DRESS CODE 2021-2022



Wearing the Mentor/TEAM school uniform encourages students to develop pride in their school and in themselves. Our students are expected to adhere to the School Dress Code as outlined below. Uniforms are worn daily and must be in good repair at all times (*buttons on blazers, shoes polished, etc.*). Students or parents with questions about the Dress Code should speak with the principal. It is mandatory to be in **"Full Dress Uniform"** (*blazer*) on **Fridays**, during assemblies, field trips, and other scheduled full dress uniform days.

All of the items listed below can be purchased at InSchoolwear ([www.inschoolwear.com](http://www.inschoolwear.com) ... registration password is "mentor"). If items are purchased elsewhere (*eg: shirts, pants*), they must be **identical** in style, shade, and colour to those sold at InSchoolwear. Our school store is "The MT Room" ([www.themtroom.com](http://www.themtroom.com)) and is located at the Main Campus. The MT Room sells new gym uniform items and has access to used dress uniform pieces from the Mentor TEAM Parent Association (MTPA) as well. Please refer to the back of this sheet for locations, hours, and contact information of these stores.

Uniform requirements (*with suggested quantities in brackets*) are outlined below. Items marked with an asterisk must be purchased from either InSchoolwear or The MT Room.

Dress Uniform (Standard Items)	
<b>* BLAZER</b>	(1) navy blazer with school crest on left chest pocket and buttons
<b>* TIE</b>	(2) blackwatch tie
<b>SHIRT</b>	(5) standard white dress shirt with pointed collar and straight sleeves
<b>PANTS with DRESS SOCKS</b>	(2 pair) medium grey dress pants, straight leg cut, conservative fit, non-stretch material <i>(note: in High School, pants with belt loops must be accompanied by a black dress belt with a conservative buckle)</i>  (5 pairs) navy, dark grey, or black socks
or	<b>TUNIC/KILT with KNEE SOCKS or TIGHTS</b> (1) blackwatch tunic or kilt, hem no more than 10 centimetres above the knee <i>(kilt used from Grade 4 to Grade 12, tunic from Junior Kindergarten to Grade 3)</i>  (5 pairs total of) plain navy knee socks and/or plain navy tights
<b>SHOES</b>	(1 pair) black, leather (or leather-like) dress shoes, maximum heel heights as follows: JK to Grade 4 - not more than 2.5 cm Grades 5 to 8 - not more than 3.75 cm Grades 9 to 12 - not more than 5 cm

Physical Education (Gym) Uniform	
<b>*T-SHIRT</b>	(1) grey t-shirt with school name
<b>*SWEATSHIRT</b>	(1) grey sweatshirt with school name
<b>*SHORTS</b>	(1) navy shorts with school name
<b>*SWEATPANTS</b>	(1) navy sweatpants with school name
<b>SHOES</b>	(2 pairs) 1 for outdoors and 1 non-marking for indoors
<b>SOCKS</b>	(1 pair) white athletic socks

Dress Uniform (Optional Items)	
<b>* SWEATER</b>	navy v-neck pullover with embroidered school name
<b>* VEST</b>	navy v-neck pullover with embroidered school name
<b>SHORTS</b>	JK to Grade 4 only knee-length dress shorts ( <i>same style and colour as dress pants</i> ) knee socks must be worn ( <i>grey or navy blue</i> )
<b>KILT/TUNIC SHORTS</b>	recommended and available at InSchoolwear and The MT Room

- Please label each item of your child's uniform with his/her name.
  - Jewellery must be removed before each physical education (gym) class so we recommend that students refrain from wearing jewellery on the days they have gym.
